

About Vedavalli

"To share Vedic Chant is to share an experience of silence through listening, a process of healing, and a link with nature, the deeper self and the divine." - TKV Desikachar

Vedavalli was established at the request of TKV Desikachar and follows the Mantra and Vedic Chant teachings taught to him by his teacher T Krishnamacharya. It aims to support and honour the essence of Mantra and Vedic Chant, by transmitting it in the West respecting the spirit of adhyayanam. Adhyayanam is the Sanskrit name for Mantra and Vedic Chant taught within personal and group meetings between students and a teacher.

In the West Mantra and Vedic Chant is also taught respecting differences in our culture, religion and personal backgrounds.

Within the UK and Ireland the transmission of Mantra and Vedic Chant, as taught by TKV Desikachar to his student Paul Harvey, is represented through Vedavalli. This national study and training organisation supports teachers who have worked with a Mantra and Vedic Chant teacher for at least three years before training as a Vedavalli chant teacher.

Registered and Accredited Vedavalli Chant teachers offer personal lessons, seminars, workshops, study courses and retreats for all those interested.

The Art of Mantra and Vedic Chanting

Introductory Workshop Study Course

This Course is open to anyone interested in Sound, Mantra and Vedic chant. All are welcome irrespective of any background or contact though some prior experience of chanting is required as a prerequisite.

Course Outline

Framework:

To offer an Introductory Course in learning the Art of Sound, Mantra and Vedic Chant through:

- Gaining confidence in finding your chanting voice and developing your breathing through Sound and Mantra.
- An appreciation and familiarity with the principles which inspire Sound, Mantra and Vedic chant practice.
- Learning how to sound Mantra in Sanskrit.
- Exploring the value of chanting in promoting health and vitality, and supporting meditation.

Aims:

To present an experience of Sound, Mantra and Vedic chanting through which students can develop their own personal practice and appreciation for it in their lives. Its role is not to train Vedic chant teachers although it can form part of the pre-requisites for teacher training.

Certification:

A Vedavalli Introductory Workshop certificate is awarded to successful students. This course is a pre-requisite for further levels of training within the Vedavalli framework.

Course Structure and Costs

The course consists of 10 scheduled hours, arranged as 4 evening meetings:

Monday evenings 6.30 – 9.30 pm

31st January

7th, 14th & 28th February

The cost of the course is £80 payable in full upon enrolment. Please note that these payments are not refundable in any circumstances.
